

ARTIFICIAL GRASS INSTALLATION

From vision to reality — cover any surface, enjoy every moment.

1. Surface Preparation



Clean the surface from any weeds and/or natural grass (remove them from the root).

2. Placement of Geotextile



Place the geotextile over the entire surface to reduce the likelihood of weed growth in the future.

3. Sand Spreading



Distribute concrete sand with a thickness of at least 3 cm for better drainage. Next: water the sand and press it with a roller.

4. Installation of Turf



Lay the pieces of artificial grass on the ground and open them starting from the corner of the surface.

5. Cutting Synthetic Turf



Cut the grass from the top. Place the next piece of grass and align parallel to the previous piece.

Important: Ensure that the pile direction is facing the same way.




6. Joining Pieces

For small surfaces it is recommended to use adhesive tape. Lift and fold back both pieces of artificial grass. Place the adhesive tape between them and stick down the two pieces of artificial grass pressing firmly down.



For large surfaces use two-component glue and joint tape. Lift and fold back both pieces of artificial grass. Place the joint tape between the two rolls (shiny side down). Apply the glue evenly across the tape and stick down the two pieces of artificial grass pressing firmly down.

7. Perimeter Stabilization



Secure the perimeter using 16 cm long nails at a distance of 30-50 cm between them.

Your garden is finished! Enjoy it with your loved ones.

8. Lawn Brushing



Finally straighten up the fibers by brushing or blowing with an electric blower against the pile direction.
